REQUIREMENTS FOR A SNOWBALL STAND

1. Structure must be screened or have a separate screened or enclosed container for syrup products.
2. Ice must be kept protected in a cleanable container.
3. Wood must be painted or sealed to facilitate cleaning.
4. An ice scoop must be provided.
5. Cups and other utensils must be kept protected (in a dispenser or plastic sleeve).
6. Ice must be from an approved source.
7. Syrup flavors must be commercially prepared in a licensed kitchen and not made from concentrates by the Snowball Stand Operator.
8. A food establishment license will be required. Please call 410-313-1772 for an application and to set up an inspection.
9. Arrangements must be provided for access to rest room facilities for the employees.
10. A set up must be provided for hand washing. This can be accomplished by using a camp sink or spigot to provide running water. Provide soap, paper towels and a trashcan and a container to catch the dirty water.
11. No other food items can be sold from the stand.
