Degree Program Requirements

- Only Howard County Police Recruit Officers are eligible for this program.
- Satisfactory completion of Howard Community College placement testing is required.
- Successful completion of the 30-week Howard County Police Academy, with an additional four weeks of academics also is required.
- Participants must be willing to attend courses on Saturdays during the academy to satisfy general degree requirements.
